- 3. When have you felt "called," like you were doing what you were put on earth to do? That the Lord has given you something you need to do, to fulfill His work? What talents lend to this work? What do you think your "personal ministry" is? What might you do to better understand and fulfill this ministry?
- 4. Have you felt God knows you? Here in this life? Before this world? What has helped you feel/know this? Feel it in your body right now. Write about this feeling in your journal. Bring these to the Lord and continue to seek understanding.
- 5. **Exercise:** List as many ways to "go about doing good" as you can think of. List your specific gifts and talents. Write about how these two columns might converge, to form your personal ministry.
- 6. Do you receive the ministering of others? Do you ever block it? What might you do to let others better minister to you?
