- 6. How have "the 2 sticks," or books, of "Judah" and "Ephraim," or The Holy Bible and The Book of Mormon: Another Testament of Jesus Christ, strengthened your testimony, understanding & faith in Him? Share your feelings on this with others—on social media, with friends, anywhere—this week.
