- 5) When you ponder the concept of "charity," what comes to mind? How do you feel? How are you seeking to receive God's love for YOU? Have you prayed and asked to be shown God's love for you? What if you knelt right now and asked Him to show you how He feels about you? What could this change in your life? Write about this and discuss with your family or a friend this week.
