- 1) What does it mean to you to "live with vision?" Have you ever created your "vision"? If so, revisit and make sure it doesn't need any adjustments for where you are now. If not, use the following article to create your vision. Write about this.

- 2) Do you ever feel like you're in a "dark and dreary wilderness"? In what ways? What do you do in these times? How might you better turn to the Lord, seek His help, and receive His "mercy"? What things help you get out of the dreariness?
- 3) What kind of "wilderness" of life are you in now? Listen to 20:00-21:15 to help. Use this understanding of where you currently are in life to create your vision of where you want to be: a) today, b) this month, c) this year, d) 5 years from now, etc.
- 4) As you listen to 21:14-27:28, ponder the Love of God, or Charity. How are you seeking, asking for, and receiving this pure and great love? Are you doing so often? If so, how often? If not, what stands in your way? How might you better receive His love daily, hourly, moment by moment?
- 5) 4 Questions to Ask as You Read The Book of Mormon. Where am I in this story? Or "How does this story relate to my life?"
 - a) Where is Jesus Christ in this story?
 - b) What is He trying to teach me here?
 - c) What do I do about it? (Or "therefore, what?")

Ponder how you might use these to feel the Spirit & gain a testimony of *The Book or Mormon* & apply its life-saving principles to help you become more like Him.

6) In what ways might you be "feeling your way" through the "mists of darkness"?

What can you do to find your way, with Christ, through the dark? Write about this.
